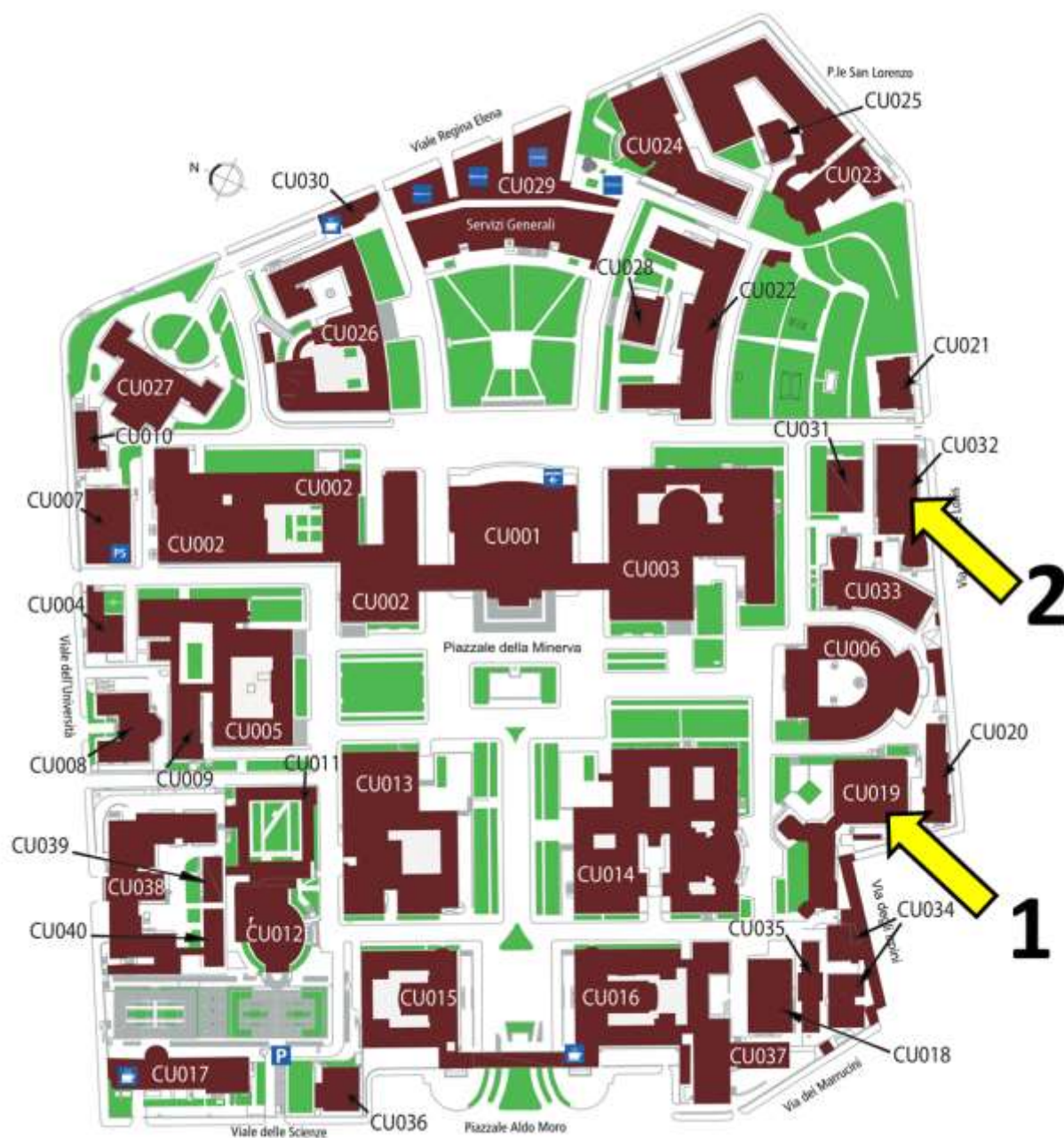

HOW TO REACH SAPIENZA CAMPUS

From Termini Railway Station to Sapienza University of Rome

Subway: Line B from the stop "TERMINI" to the stop "POLICLINICO" From the stop, continue on Viale Regina Elena (7 minutes, 0.6 km).

Walking: leave the station through the right side exit (Via Marsala), turn right on Via Marsala, turn left on Via del Castro Pretorio, continue on Viale dell'Universita', turn right on Viale Regina Elena (17 minutes, 1.4 km).

From Fiumicino "Leonardo Da Vinci" Airport

By train: We suggest the non-stop Leonardo express train to and from Termini station (connecting with the Metro – lines A e B); it leaves every 30 minutes and takes 31 minutes to get to Termini station.

From Ciampino "G.B. Pastine" Airport

By Bus + metro: To get to Rome city center you can catch a bus (Cotral) at the airport to Metro Line A station Anagnina. From there you can ride the underground to Termini (it takes about 30 minutes). Buses leave every 40 minutes

By bus: Terravision Shuttle Bus serves also the route between Ciampino airport and Termini station. It leaves about every 30 minutes from Arrivals area bus stop n°3.
